Mystic woodland sanctum for children as contemporary emulation

The architects have created an enchantingly mystic hybrid-timber building with a walkout basement set into a slope, its architecture emulating the terrain, perfectly adapted to the surrounding woodland. The brightly framed entrance is set at an angle within the two-storey timber façade made of charred spruce and contrasting glazed teal spruce that weaves a pattern. To the south, there is a protective access balcony structure with ultra-slim steel columns and two hot-dip galvanised steel stairways descending to the playground. Timber and steel form a creative workshop space for children. The embedded glazed walkout basement with its movement space is filled with atmosphere. Reflections and the supporting structure showing through as a stylised root system interconnect architecture and nature. The defined organisation of space and the communication between materials and colours bring a forest clearing to mind. Walls of light-coloured spruce grow out of an earthy rubber floor. Sulphur-yellow oak doors symbolise forest flowers. Window seats and wood wool panels forming a blue canopy make nature a central theme.
